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OPEN NATIONAL INVITATION TO TENDER

TWO (02) INDEPENDENT LOTS, IN EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

FUNDING : Budget of the NSIF

1. Subject of the Invitation to Tender

This National Open Call for Tender is launched for the rehabilitation of communal areas of the « tour du Wouri » building in Douala in two (02) independent lots.

2. Consistency of Works

The work, subject of this Invitation to Tender include:

- **Demolitions:** removal and demolition of networks and terminals of plumbing, electricity of communal; removal of the sealing complex; dismantling of both elevators as well as all the wood and metal joinery in the entrance hall;
- **Masonry:** repair of the slope shapes of the terrace roofs, resumption of the borders of the green spaces, reinforced concrete of the bins of the showers and massifs of foundation for blower;
- **Carpentry:** recovery of ceilings and staff of the lobby
- **Plumbing:** Overhaul of the water supply and drainage piping including all valve and valve installation problems, then replacement of defective equipment and fire safety system;
- **Electricity:** Rehabilitation and compliance of facilities including replacement of all lighting and socket terminals of communal areas;
- **Sealing:** Sealing of the terrace roof
- **Painting:** Rehabilitation of the exterior paintings of the fence
- **Metalwork:** Replacement of grides and gates of the fence wall and banister;

Others: Replacement of two elevators, site installation, site cleaning and waste transportation to the dump.

In any case, the works include all the details of the quantitative estimate attached to this file and all constraints necessary for their perfect execution.

3. Execution Deadline

The deadline foreseen by the Client for execution of works subject of this Invitation to Tender is ninety (90) days for each lot.

4. Allotment

The work is divided into two lots as defined below:

- Lot 1 : False ceiling, metalwork, sealing and plumbing
- Lot 2 : Electricity, security and elevator

5. Estimated Cost

Estimated cost at the end of preliminary studies is **CFA F (excluding taxes) HTT 274 631 730 (two hundred and seventy four million, six hundred and thirty one thousand, seven hundred and thirty)** divided as follows:

- **Lot 1** : False ceiling, metalwork, sealing and plumbing: **FCFA HTT 128 348 925 (one hundred and twenty eight million, three hundred and forty eight thousand, nine hundred and twenty five)**;
- **Lot 2** : Electricity, security and elevator: **FCFA HTT 146 282 805 (one hundred and forty six million, two hundred and eighty two thousand, eight hundred and five)** ;

6. Participation and Origin

Participation to this Invitation to Tender is opened to Construction and Public Work Companies established under Cameroonian law, with proven experience in this type of work.

7. Funding

Work subject of this Invitation to Tender shall be financed from the budget programme 2018-2022 of the National Social Insurance Fund, on budget line 6-2D2206 in accordance with programme P106.

8. Provisional Guarantee

Each bidder must attach to his administrative documents a bid bond issued by a first-rate bank approved by the Ministry of Finance, specifying an amount of:

- **2 566 000 (two million, five hundred and sixty six thousand)** CFA Francs for lot 1 ;
- **2 925 000 (two million, nine hundred and twenty five thousand)** CFA Francs for lot 2 ;

The deposit shall be valid thirty (30) days beyond the original expiry date of offers.

9. Consultation of Tender File

The Tender file may be consulted during working hours at the Contracts Unit located at the 9th floor, room 903 of the NSIF Head Office building, Independence Square upon publication of this notice to Tender on the NSIF website (www.cnps.cm) and the notice board.

10. Acquisition of Tender File

The Tender file may be obtained during working hours at the Contracts Unit located at the 9th floor, room 903 of the NSIF Head Office building upon publication of this notice to Tender, against presentation of a payment receipt of a non-refundable amount of CFA Francs **140.000 (one hundred and forty thousand)** in NSIF Special Account opened in UBA bank No. 1003 3052 0707 0070 00003-93

Upon withdrawal of the File, bidders must in any case be registered by leaving their complete address (PO Box, telephone contacts).

11. Submission of Offers

Each bid drafted in French or English, in six (06) copies, including one (01) original and five (05) copies labelled as such should reach the Contracts Unit no later than **20 march 2019 at 2 pm**, local time and shall be labelled:

12. Admissibility of Offers

Subject to being rejected, the administrative documents required must be produced in originals or certified true copies by the issuing service or an administrative authority in accordance with the stipulation specified in the Invitation to Tender.

These documents must not be older than three (03) months preceding the original date of submission of bids or been established after the date of signature of the Tender notice.

Any incomplete Tender in accordance with the prescriptions of this Notice to Tender shall be declared inadmissible, especially the absence of the bid bond issued by a first-rate bank approved by the Ministry of Finance.

13. Opening of Bids

Bids shall be opened in one phase.

The opening of administrative documents and the technical and financial offers shall take place on **20 march 2019 at 2:30 pm**, local time, by the Internal Commission of the Tenders Board of the National Social Insurance Fund.

Only bidder shall attend the bids opening session or be represented by a duly mandated person.

14. Evaluation Criteria

➤ Eliminary Criteria

Eliminary criteria include:

- False statement, replacement or forged administrative documents;
- Absence of an administrative document at the opening of bids or non-compliance of one of the administrative documents (however, the bidder has a deadline of 48 h, to produce a compliant document, otherwise he shall be eliminated);
- Absence of a declaration of non-withdrawal and non-default in the performance of contracts prior to the NSIF countersigned by the Client or his representative and the bidder;
- Absence of the site visit certificate countersigned by the head of structure of the locality beneficiary of the work and the bidder;
- **Absence of an approval issued by the CNPS in the domain concerned or of a request where appropriate;**
- Absence of a quantify price unit in the financial offer ;
- Non-validation of at least 70% of the evaluation criteria;
- Lack of realization of civil engineering works for an accumulated amount of at least 38.000.000 for lot No.1 and of electrical engineering works for an accumulated amount of at least 43.000.000 for lot No.2, during the last five years ;
- Non-compliance with CSR standards:
 - Workforce affiliated at the NSIF: higher or equal to 3 (online declaration of last 03 months), a detailed list of personnel with their individual insured NSIF numbers, attach clearance certificate (APS) showing update of payment of contributions;
 - Fair remuneration (respect of SMIG: attach DIPE or salary statements);
 - Respect of the principle of gender promotion: justify at least 20% of the female workers in the workforce (attach DIPE, list of personnel and gender report);
 - Liability insurance covering the current financial year (attach insurance policy).

Bidders shall remain committed to their offers within a period of ninety (90) days from the date set for the submission of their bids.
